The California Joint Powers Risk Management Authority (CJPRMA) is a statewide risk retention pool that was established in 1986 to provide excess general liability coverage for its members. Currently, its membership is composed of 17 cities and 4 joint powers authorities. The combined membership represents about 100 public entities throughout the state.

This session will provide attendees with an in-depth description of the CJPRMA General Liability Insurance Program, an occurrence based risk retention program which utilizes some commercial reinsurance. The session will review, in detail, the Memorandum of Coverage, including a discussion of covered perils, limits, exclusions and the claims process and a complete discussion of the claims processing requirements. We will also discuss the history of the program, how development has occurred over time and the benefits to the members of CJPRMA. This is a must-attend program for all participants.
