The California Joint Powers Risk Management Authority (CJPRMA) is a statewide risk retention pool that was established in 1986 to provide excess general liability coverage for its members. Currently, its membership is composed of 17 cities and 5 joint powers authorities. The combined membership represents about 100 public entities throughout the state.

This session will provide attendees with an in-depth description of the CJPRMA Commercial Insurance Programs including Property, Auto Physical Damage and Boiler & Machinery. The session will review, in detail, the new Property Memorandum of Coverage, including a discussion of covered perils, limits, exclusions and the claims process. The Auto Physical Damage program will be discussed in detail, describing the valuation process for equipment in the program and a complete discussion of the claims processing requirements. Mr. Cooney will also discuss the history of these programs, how they have developed over time and how they benefit the members of CJPRMA. This is a must-attend program for all participants.
